

# Northwood Battle of the books

## Step One-- Choose your book

Review the Battle titles online, [www.neropta.com](http://www.neropta.com) and decide which book interests you. You may read the book alone or have a parent read it with you.

## Step Two --Select your team and Register

Each battle team may have up to 3-5 team members. You may sign up as a team or individually and we will place you on a team. Sign up online at [www.neropta.com](http://www.neropta.com). You may have team members from any grade on your team, just as long as you are reading the same book.

## Step Three -- Read and Know your Book!

You will be asked questions about your book during the Battle. Make sure you finish your book in time for the monthly battle. We recommend that you plan, get your team together right before the battle and discuss your book.

## Step Four --The Battle Format

You and your team will be placed in a battle round. Each round may have 2 -3 battle teams. Each team will have 15 seconds to answer their question (each team will be asked the same # of questions from their book). Teams will be asked approx. 10 questions, depending on the # of participants. Teams will choose a "Team Captain". The team captain will be responsible for reciting the team's answer to the battle host. At the end of each round each team will place the points accumulated on their own personal "Battle Card" to begin the quest to be the player to collect the greatest number of points by the conclusion of the school year. This will be an ongoing game, so readers can form new teams with different students based on reading preferences.
